The University Administration shall provide bargaining unit faculty members with 7 8 facilities and services appropriate to the performance of their job duties and conducive to 9 performing their duties in a professional atmosphere. 10 11 Section 2. The University Administration shall provide Officers of Instruction with a university email address, with a mailbox, a telephone number and voicemail, reasonable office space and 12 desk space (all of which may be shared space), and reasonable access to a telephone, a computer, 13 14 secure storage space, a printer, a copier, private space for meeting with students, and access to electronic course management systems such as Blackboard. 15 16 Section 3. The University Administration shall provide Officers of Research with a university 17 email address, with a mailbox, a telephone number and voicemail, appropriate workspace, and 18 appropriate equipment to complete assigned work (all of which may be shared). 19 20 Section 4. Bargaining unit faculty shall have the right to access their work facilities when needed 21 for the performance of their professional responsibilities. However, this shall not preclude the 22 University Administration from restricting access when it deems necessary for university 23 24 operations. 25 Section 5. A bargaining unit faculty member shall be provided one classroom for the duration of 26 a class period, except for pedagogical reasons, safety, or in case of emergency. A bargaining unit 27 faculty member may discuss with his or her supervisor preferences for or concerns about specific 28 classrooms before assignments are made. Assigned classrooms shall be adequate to 29 accommodate the number of students enrolled in a course. Assigned classrooms will have the 30 technology and technological support appropriate for the course. 31 32 33 The University Administration may change a classroom assignment if a classroom is determined 34 to be inaccessible for a student or employee. A bargaining unit faculty member should notify the Office of the Registrar as soon as he or she identifies a barrier to the access of a student or 35 36 employee to or within a classroom. The University will comply with all applicable laws 37 regarding disabilities and access for bargaining unit faculty members. 38 39 Section 6. All bargaining unit faculty shall be assigned, and shall be expected to use for university purposes, a University of Oregon email account, a Duckweb account, and a DuckID at 40 least 15 days before the employment start date or as soon as practicable. Bargaining unit 41

members shall follow University procedures and provide requested information in order to obtain

All bargaining unit faculty members not terminated for cause and who have complied with terms of this Agreement and all policies applicable to the use of university email shall be provided access to a University of Oregon email account, a Duckweb account, and university courseware for at least two (2) one terms after the end of their employment. The former bargaining unit faculty member must continue to comply with the terms of this Agreement and all policies applicable to the use of university email.

Section 7. The University <u>Administration</u> shall comply with all laws regarding accessibility of web-based communications.

The University <u>Administration</u> shall furnish appropriate aids and services to bargaining unit faculty with disabilities as required by law.

In determining what type of auxiliary aid and service is necessary, the University <u>Administration</u> shall be responsive to the requests of the bargaining unit faculty member with disabilities.
