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6	Section 1. The Union shall have the right to communicate with its members and the
7	members of the bargaining unit at all times without interference by the University
8 9	<u>Administration</u> provided such communication does not interfere with the work duties of the faculty a bargaining unit member, University operations, students, other employees,
10	or, while on property owned or controlled by the University, members of the public.
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12	Section 2. The Union shall have the right to use university facilities and services,
13	including, but not limited to, email, telephones, audio-visual, computing, and meeting
14	rooms, on the same basis as other non-University entities employee organizations.
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16	Section 3. The Union shall have the right to prominent space on existing bulletin boards
17	in each department or unit where bargaining unit members are employed, but the
18	University Administration may remove or relocate such bulletin boards in its sole and
19	absolute discretion.
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21	Section 4. The Union shall have the right to a list of information for all members of the
22 23	bargaining unit delivered quarterly on the first day of the month at no cost to the union and in a mutually agreeable format. The list shall include the following information:

38	Section 5. The Union shall have the right to an annual report of all promotion and tenure
39 40	decisions concerning bargaining unit <u>faculty</u> members made by the Provost or designee during the preceding academic year no later than the following September 1.

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1	Section 6. The University will make available at new employee orientation for members
2	of the bargaining unit information about the Union mutually agreed upon by the
3	University and the Union.
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5	The Union shall have the right to make a presentation, if presentations are made at, and
6	distribute information at, orientations for new faculty members.
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8	Section 7. The Union shall have the right to information and data necessary to administer
9	this Agreement upon the payment of the actual cost of producing the information.
10	Information and data shall be made available in electronic form whenever possible.
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12	Section 8. The Union shall have the right to meaningful participation in the development
13	of all programs and/or policies where the state requires that there be faculty input.
