27	bargaining unit delivered on the first day of the month at no cost to the union and in a
28	mutually agreeable format. The list shall include the following information:

9	Section 7. The Union shall have the right to information and data necessary to administer

13	Section 8. Bargaining unit faculty members shall be included in the development of all
14	programs and/or policies where the state requires that there be faculty input.
