6	Section 1. The Union shall have the right to communicate with its members and the
7	members of the bargaining unit at all times without interference of the Administration
8	provided such communication does not interfere with the normal duties of the faculty.
9	
10	Section 2. The Union shall have the right to access university facilities and services,
11	including, but not limited to, email, telephones, audio-visual, computing, and meeting
12	rooms.
13	
14	Section 3. The Union shall have the right to prominent space on existing bulletin boards
15	in each department or unit where faculty are employed.
16	
17	Section 4. The Union shall have the right to a list of directory information for all
18	members of the bargaining unit delivered on the first (1st) of each month, or nearest
19	working day, at no cost to the union and in a mutually agreeable format. The list shall
20	include the following information:

4	Section 5. The Union shall have the right to an annual report of all promotion and tenure
5	decisions concerning bargaining unit members made by the Provost and President during
6	the preceding academic year no later than the following August 1.

8	Section 6. The Union shall have the right to make a presentation of no less than ten (10)
9	minutes and deliver information at the New Faculty Orientation put on by Academic
10	Affairs.
11	
12	Section 7. The Union shall have the right to information and data necessary to administer
13	this agreement. Information and data shall be made available in electronic form whenever
14	possible.

16	Section 8. The Union shall have the right to participate as equal partners in the
17	development of all programs or policies where the state requires that there be faculty
18	input.
