7	with an excellent education is one of our highest priorities. Accordingly, both parties
8	agree that class sizes should be kept as low as possible. The Administration and the
9	Union agree that the percentage of undergraduate classes, as defined and reported in the
10	Common Data Set, taught with less than 20 students during the 2013-14 academic year
11	shall be greater than 42%.

16	Section 3. By September 16, each department or unit that employs Officers of Instruction
17	shall publish the unit's goal percentage of undergraduate classes taught with less than 20
18	students for the coming academic year on the unit's website under the heading "Class
19	Size Goal." If the unit does not have a website, the information should be posted in a
20	conspicuous location accessible to the university community.

22	Section 4. On August 1, the Administration will send to the Union a report on the
23	university's percentage of undergraduate classes taught with less than 20 students for the
24	proceeding academic year, the percentage of undergraduate classes taught with less than
25	20 students for all departments and units that employ Officers of Instruction, and a list of
26	the undergraduate classes and enrollment.

28	Section 5. By September 16, each department or unit that employs Officers of Instruction
29 30	shall publish the unit's percentage of undergraduate classes taught with less than 20
31	students for the previous academic year, the undergraduate class size median, and the undergraduate class size mean on the unit's website under the heading "Student/Instructor
32	ratio." If the unit does not have a website, the information should be posted in a
33	conspicuous location accessible to the university community.
