6	Section 1. The University Administration will continue employer premium contributions
7	at the present levels for PEBB health, dental, and life benefits chosen by bargaining unit
8	faculty members who are employed at .50FTE and higher.

.0	Section 2. In the event that the Public Employee Benefits Board should increase
.1	deductibles or out-of-pocket expenses, each enrolled faculty member will receive a one-
2	time "offset payment" in an amount equal to the maximum increase.

4	Section 3. The Union and the University Administration agree to create a joint labor-
15	management committee to deliberate in the fall of 2013 and determine how to distribute
l6	the sum of up \$1 million per calendar year, beginning on January 1, 2014, to address the
17	following issues (in order of priority):

19	a. Addressing the health insurance needs of people under .50FTE in a manner
20	that benefits them under the Affordable Care Act
21	b. Creating health savings or reimbursement accounts
