

**UNIVERSITY COUNTERPROPOSAL**  
**5-7-13**

**ARTICLE 34**  
**FACILITIES and SUPPORT**

**Section 1.** The University shall provide bargaining unit faculty members with facilities and services appropriate to the performance of their job duties.

**Section 2.** The University shall provide Officers of Instruction with a University email address, reasonable office or desk space (which may be shared space), and reasonable access to a telephone, computer, storage space, a printer, a copier, space for meeting with students, and access to electronic course management systems such as Blackboard.

**Section 3.** The University shall provide Officers of Research with a University email address, appropriate workspace, and appropriate equipment to complete assigned work.

**Section 4.** A bargaining unit faculty member shall be provided one classroom for the duration of a class period, except for pedagogical reasons or in case of emergency. A bargaining unit faculty member may discuss with his or her supervisor preferences for or concerns about specific classrooms before assignments are made.

A classroom assignment may be changed if a classroom is determined to be inaccessible for a student or employee. A bargaining unit faculty member should notify the Office of the Registrar as soon as he or she identifies a barrier to the access of a student or employee to or within a classroom. The University will comply with all applicable laws regarding disabilities and access for bargaining unit faculty members.

**Section 5.** Bargaining unit faculty members shall be provided with a University email address, a DuckID account, and access to Duckweb.
