For the purpose of negotiating a successor agreement, the Union will send written notice to the University no later than 180 days prior to the expiration of this 8 9 Agreement indicating its desire to negotiate a successor agreement. Prior to commencement of negotiations, the Union and the University shall provide written notice 10 to the other specifying those subjects or sections of the Agreement proposed to be 11 reopened and new subjects for negotiation. New issues may be proposed by either party 12 at the first meeting where proposals are exchanged or later by mutual agreement. Those 13 sections of this Agreement not reopened by said notices or by subsequent mutual 14 agreement shall automatically become a part of any successor agreement. Negotiation of 15 the successor agreement shall begin no later than 150 days prior to the expiration of this 16 Agreement or such date thereafter as may be mutually agreed upon by the parties. 17 18 Section 2. The Union agrees to schedule a ratification vote by the membership within 19 20 two weeks, excluding finals week of the date of signing a tentative agreement with the University on a successor Agreement. 21 22 Section 3. This Agreement will expire on ______. The parties will comply 23 with the applicable provisions of ORS Chapter 243 in negotiating a successor agreement 24 and with regard to rights, obligations and procedure if a successor agreement is not 25 signed prior to the expiration of this Agreement. 26
